

Professor Daya MOODLEY

Daya holds a PhD on Perinatal HIV Transmission and Diagnosis. She works as an associate professor at the Women's Health and HIV Research Unit of the Nelson R Mandela School of Medicine in South Africa. She is also the International Vice-Chairperson of the Perinatal/Maternal Health Scientific Committee of IMPAACT Group.

She is a highly accomplished researcher having done extensive work on Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission (PMTCT) of HIV. As a director of a KZN provincial PMTCT Programme between 2000 and 2005, Daya has achieved significant milestones that have greatly advanced this province's objectives in HIV/AIDS diagnosis, treatment, prevention, counselling and support.

She is widely published on material that was co-authored with other local and international experts . She also served as a member of a string of international professional associations, mainly on health and HIV/AIDS. These include the World Health Organisation (WHO).
